A phenomenon occurs in the Mojave Desert, between sunrise and stargaze, where endless combinations of colors are found within the sky and landscape. Translating this into painted form, are pairs of colors stacked vertically. These forms are abstractions of eyes, from which to see and to awaken. Inspired by 'Eyes of the World' (Garcia/Hunter)*, a song of poetic variation, one that draws a parallel to the infinite colors of Joshua Tree, California.
